



May 2019: Derry Township 69kV Power Line Rebuild Project Update

Our team spent the past month in the Hershey area digging test holes and soil borings to gather information on Homestead Road, Derry Township School and parts of Cocoa and Elm Avenue. This information is used to design the underground line. We will continue digging test holes and drilling soil borings throughout May.

We've also been working with landowners to secure easements for the underground line, so we can build the underground lines through their properties. The proposed underground line route will not be finalized until we know where we have easement rights.

In addition, we shared our plan and proposed agreement to move our poles underground with Comcast and Verizon. Comcast and Verizon have not yet entered into an agreement. The decision on whether the communication lines are routed underground with our lines is Comcast and Verizon's decision. By end of May, we will know whether they are moving their lines underground with our lines.

Our team is on track to start construction along Homestead Road this summer. We also anticipate starting construction across the Derry Township School Property to Elm Avenue by this Fall.

We'll continue to keep you updated on the project by sharing monthly updates in the Derry Township eNews and sending letters bi-monthly. As construction begins, we will also provide door-to-door outreach to impacted residents.
