



July 2019: Derry Township 69kV Power Line Rebuild Project Update

The design for the underground route near Homestead Road and Derry Township school is complete, and we started construction in this area. In addition, there will be construction activity on the northern section of Elm Avenue at the intersection of W. 9th Street beginning this month. All property owners affected by the construction were notified.

During construction, you can expect to see traffic controls and some road closures, depending upon what type of construction activities we are doing.

The remainder of the line is being engineered. During this time, we will continue digging test holes and sampling the soil.

We do not expect to start construction on the remainder of the line until Spring 2020, which will include the remainder of Elm Avenue lying south of W. 9th Street spanning to W. Governor Road. The existing aboveground transmission line will be removed once the underground line is complete.

We'll continue to keep you updated on the project by sharing monthly updates in the Derry Township eNews and sending letters bi-monthly.
